### <u>Aiken Canyon Preserve Hike</u> Saturday, October 26, 10:00 AM - 4:00 PM

This will be a moderate 5-1/2 mile hike with about 500 feet of elevation gain.

Aiken Canyon Preserve is a 1,621 acre state natural area about 12 miles south of Colorado Springs, managed by the Nature Conservancy under a long-term lease. It is a mixture of foothills, shrubland and woodland habitats, and continues to be an area particularly rich in wildlife and birdlife. We will learn about the history of the area and how it serves as a valuable wildlife corridor.

### Browns Canyon National Monument Climate Hike Saturday, November 16, 9:00 AM - 3:00 PM

Join Wild Connections and <u>Friends of Browns Canyon</u> for a hike down middle Cottonwood Creek in <u>Browns Canyon</u> <u>National Monument</u>, starting from Bassam Park.

This will be a moderate hike of about 6 miles round-trip and 1,000 feet total ascent, with scenic views of the Monument as well as the Sawatch Range/Collegiate Peaks across the valley.

We will also be retrieving data loggers that have been recording temperature, humidity and other data for the past few weeks. Browns Canyon National Monument was identified as being one of the "Best" areas for Climate Refugia in Wild Connections Climate Corridor and Refugia Analysis. Learn more on the hike!
